Things to Do

The Aloha Safari Zoo has so many exciting things to see. Listed below are some things you should definitely check out during your visit!

- Stop by our goat and pig field near the zoo entrance to feed our livestock animals some treats that you can purchase at the front entrance. Remember, we ask that you don't feed the horses or giraffe any food from the feed bag.
- Head to the Giraffe House to feed our giraffes some snacks! Make sure to keep hats, sunglasses, cell phones, cameras, and umbrellas out of their reach! They love taking souvenirs from visitors!
- Take a ride through the drive-through section of our park to see some of our larger hoof stock animals! They come right up to your vehicle, and you can pet and feed most of them! You will see and feed animals such as bison, zebra, ostriches, antelope, donkeys, llamas, water buffalo, camels, and even some animals you've never heard of!
- Tour our upper section of animals by foot by following the paved walkways! You will come face to face with tigers, lemurs, wolves, monkeys, and other exotic animals!
- Head to the Reptile Room to see some of our exotic reptiles such as bearded dragons, ball pythons, and Burmese pythons!
- Head through our indoor animal area of our main building to see exotic birds, iguanas and more!
- If you have any questions on any of the animals that you see on your visit or on the facility itself, be sure to find someone in a "Zoo Staff" shirt and they will be happy to answer your questions!
- Stop by the Gift Shop at the entrance to pick up stuffed animals, t-shirts, and other souvenirs to take home to remember your wild time! It's at the main entrance to the zoo! There are cold drinks and snacks as well.
