



Currently, 56.6% of the 6,908 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 29.8%, renter occupied; and 13.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 6,828 housing units in the area - 54.4% owner occupied, 33.7% renter occupied, and 12.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.52%. Median home value in the area is \$99,688, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.97% annually to \$109,889.

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
